

Arizona Wildcats, local business team up to help USS Arizona charity

The Underrated City clothing store on Fourth Avenue has partnered with Arizona athletics to sell t-shirts for the public that resemble the commemorative Pearl Harbor anniversary uniforms the team will wear on Saturday September 17, 2016 when they play Hawaii. The Arizona Wildcats will wear special, one-off uniforms honoring the USS Arizona in Saturday's game against Hawaii. Fans can look the part, too, with the proceeds benefiting charity.

The UA and The Underestimated City, a Fourth Avenue business, have teamed up to sell battleship gray "shirseys" — t-shirts that look like jerseys — for Saturday's game. The shirts are \$30 and can be purchased either at the shop, 402 N 4th Ave., or online.

Proceeds will benefit Arizona Final Salute, a charity that helps survivors of the Dec. 7, 1941 attack on Pearl Harbor and their immediate family return to Honolulu for the for the event's 75th anniversary.

The shirts were the brainchild of The Underestimated City co-owners Israel Zavala, who served in the Arizona Army National Guard, and Gabe Grateron. Grateron suggested donating the shirts.
